1. A declaration is required for all 100km diploma flights. It must be completed before take off. The declaration may be on the flight recorder or sheet of paper signed by an OO. 2. When the declaration is on the flight recorder, every effort should be made to ensure the pilot and glider details are correct.
3. Flight recorder evidence may be submitted on a floppy disk, CD, full size SD card or USB data storage stick. Paper printouts of flight recorder files are not acceptable evidence.
4. Your claim should include this form, the declaration, flight recorder data, your gliding certificate and/or licence and the correct fee.
