SUGGESTED CONTENT OF 3 YEAR CHECKS FOR BGA ASSISTANT AND FULL RATED INSTRUCTORS

Ideally candidates should be checked on ability to teach:

Launches

Launch Failures

Turns

Stalls and Spinning

Circuits

Ability to brief effectively for the forthcoming exercise

Factors to take into consideration before flying:

Their currency and 'style' of own flying?

How long since their last refresher?

What was the content of their last refresher?

Is there any exercise they avoid or don't get enough practice at?

Also:

Don't forget aerotow launch failures.

If you are a primarily a wire launch/aerotow site, get them to teach the other launch type.

If they only did the minimum amount of flying last renewal they should teach all the launch failures to you.

Ask them what they think they should do and what they want to do.
(i.e. include something they think they need or enjoy)

Don't forget to ask them what they thought of the refresher session afterwards.
