- The solo flight must be carried out under the supervision of a BGA Instructor **or by an Air Cadet A Category Instructor but only where the solo takes place at an Air Cadet Gliding Squadron**
- The candidate must be tested for the required knowledge of the Rules of the Air and local airspace awareness before solo flight

- One passport size photograph, signed on the back, is required before a 'B' badge can be issued.
