



## 9.0 OTHER LEGISLATION AFFECTING HEALTH AND SAFETY AT GLIDING CLUBS

Some further legislation and regulations affecting health and safety are listed below. Gliding clubs are advised to obtain the relevant publications and advice relating to the following:-

- The Highly Flammable Liquids and Liquefied Petroleum Gases Regulations, 1972, dealing with storage of fuel and re-fuelling of vehicles and aircraft on site. Administered by the Petroleum Officer of the Trading Standards dept. of the local authority.
- Fire Precautions Act, 1971 requires business premises to hold a Fire Certificate.
- Control of Substances Hazardous to Health, 1999 (COSHH).
- The Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations, 1981.
- Gas Safety (Installation and Use) Regulations, 1994.
- The Electricity at Work Regulations, 1989.
- The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations, 1999 (MHSW).
- The Personal Protective Equipment at Work Regulations, 1992 (PPE).
- The Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations, 1998 (PUWER).
- The Manual Handling Operations Regulations, 1992 (MHO).
- The Health and Safety (Display Screen Equipment) Regulations, 1992 (DSE).
- The Workplace (Health Safety and Welfare) Regulations, 1992 (HSW).
