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NOTES FOR ASSESSING INSTRUCTORS

Assessing instructors MUST be familiar with the relevant Laws and Rules requirements and the standards required as described in the BGA examiner standards publication. Where an SLMG or TMG (or aeroplane for navigation) is utilized, the instructor must hold a BGA MGIR with appropriate privileges.

The Cross-Country Endorsement can only be issued if the candidate has already qualified and applied for a Bronze Endorsement and has the approval of their CFI.

The Cross-Country Endorsement requirements (see Laws and Rules 'Gliding Certificate and Endorsements') are:

Soaring Flight

The candidate must complete a soaring flight of at least one hour in duration after release. The soaring flight must be under the supervision of a BGA instructor or Official Observer, who must complete and certify the report.

Field Selection

The candidate must demonstrate satisfactorily their ability to select or reject fields as to their suitability for landing. This exercise must be undertaken from the air but can be flown in a glider, motor glider or light aircraft.

Field Landings (normally completed as part of the Field Selection assessment)

The candidate must make a minimum of two successful approaches in a motor glider towards a field landing area selected by the candidate. The altimeter should be covered or the scale offset for this exercise. To qualify for the Endorsement, the approaches must be flown without any assistance or prompting from the instructor who must be satisfied that the candidate has demonstrated an adequate level of judgement and skill.

Navigation

The candidate must demonstrate an ability to navigate to the satisfaction of the Instructor. The candidate must plan a triangular task of at least 100 km, giving due consideration for any airspace requirements and to appropriate aspects of airmanship. During a BGA Cross Country Endorsement navigation assessment, the candidate must demonstrate the ability to read an aeronautical chart, to relate features shown on it with those features as they appear from the air and to orientate the map with respect to ground features.

This exercise can be flown in a glider, motor glider or light aircraft and only sufficient of the planned 100 km task need be flown to convince the instructor of the candidate's ability to navigate.

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
