- 4. Conditions of issue are to be found in the latest issue of BCAR A3-8. (Use for C of A renewal test flight, positioning for maintenance or storage and for flight testing a previously approved modification)
- 5. This certificate may not be used for EASA aircraft as identified in CAP 747
- 6. Passengers shall not be carried during flight under A conditions. An observer may be carried provided that associated risks are considered and accepted prior to flight. Any observer must be carried in an approved seat position.
