The list is held at: www.spsys.demon.co.uk/turningpoints.htm with notes on how it is compiled, how it should be used, and links to BGA WP data in DOS format and as a table in MS Excel so that the data can be sorted as required.

Status - Caveat. The BGA has prepared this data in good faith but takes no responsibility for its accuracy or how it is used, for instance by pilots in pre-flight planning and use in airborne navigation systems. Users are advised to check such data, in particular for proximity to other air activities or areas with airspace limitations.

Airspace. Points with airspace considerations are identified by # and ! symbols, and in the Excel table by **red lettering** and pink shading, as explained below:

A single hash is a warning about proximity to controlled or other airspace and the WP should be used with care, particularly in Competitions and other Organised Task Groups.

Points with a double hash should only be approached or over-flown if the organisation responsible for the airspace concerned has positively agreed that the point may be used for the particular flight

& ## All hash points are in **red lettering** so that they can be sorted from other types of points as required

! Points with an exclamation mark are near sensitive airspace and should not be used in Competitions or for Organised Task Groups of gliders. These points are shaded in pink so that they can be sorted from other types of Points as required

Format. Points are given below in the DOS format that follows. Through the BGA web site, tables in MS Excel format are also available which can be sorted as desired, for instance by Main reference feature, latitude, etc.
