Fairford – US military fast jets, transport, RPAS – occasionally operational (see NOTAMS)

Lakenheath – US military fast jets, transport – operational training

Leeming – Fast jets, light aircraft - training

Lossiemouth – Fast jets/other – quick reaction alert and operational training

Marham - Fast jets - operational training

Middle Wallop – Helicopters, light aircraft – training

Mildenhall – US military fast jets, transport – operational training

Northolt - Business jets - VIP flying

Odiham - Helicopters - operational training

Shawbury - Helicopters - training

Syerston - Gliders / occasional Red Arrows - training

Valley - Fast jets - training

Waddington – Large aircraft, Red Arrows, RPAS – quick reaction alert and operational training

Wattisham – Helicopters – operational training

Wittering - Light aircraft - training

Yoevilton – Helicopters – training

Note 1. 'Fast jets' includes Typhoon, Tornado, Eagle, Tucano, Hawk, etc

Note 2. 'Transport' aircraft include Hercules, C17, Airbus & Boeings various – ie BIG aircraft

Note 3. At airfields with fast jets and large aircraft, please expect the locally based aircraft to need <u>LOTS</u> of space to manouevre, so please try to stay clear of the MATZ

Note 4. Always talk to ATC in good time when operating close to active military airfields – and please don't leave it until you suddenly become very busy or you definitely need help! Your position, your height and your intentions will be very helpful to the controller and the local aircraft.
